This territory, which has led to an appellation of origin the same name, is part of the autonomous region of Catalonia, is divided into three regions (the Upper Penedès, Garraf (also called the Marina del Penedes) and Lower Penedès), and is located in the provinces of Barcelona and Tarragona. It is one of the most recognized wine-producing areas worldwide.



You can simply visit the Penedes one Sunday to have an excellent taste and out of a rut while tasting the essence of the place. But to really know him, the routes can be extended for days and weeks as it has many things to offer between wines, champagne, food, traditions, people, architecture, art and natural landscapes.
